
Photographing 2D Artwork

Tips for photographing artwork:

- Setup in a space where there is even window lighting (high noon, sunny day)
- *note one window source on either side of wall/artwork setup will suffice
- Hang/Clip artwork flat on the wall (unframed/no glass to prevent reflection)
- Photograph artwork at eye-level and hold camera/smartphone vertically, straight as possible to prevent distortian (tripod optional)



Tips for Editing artwork

(Photoshop, Snapseed app for smartphone, etc. On iphone click photo > edit > light and color: drop down tabs)

- Color balance and edit accordingly to match original artwork
- Crop and level artwork

Photographing 3D Artwork

Tips for photographing artwork:

- You will need a flat surface to place 3d artwork on (Table , Desk, etc.) 2 pcs. of white poster board / heavyweight paper and tape
- Situate table against the wall adjacent to window (natural light / light source , high noon sunny day)
- Place poster-board on the table top surface and against the wall to create seamless curve > tape down

Sizing and Formatting Requirements:

(Photoshop tabs > Image > Image Size)

(From iphone : click photo > email photo > File size option (reduce file size accordingly) (free online programs, resizeimage.net, birme.net, etc.)

File type: JPEG or JPG files only.

Max file size: 3MB

Resolution: 72 pixels/inch or 1200 pixels or greater on the longest side
